A BIT OF HISTORY

Continental center is an office skyscraper located in the financial district of Lower Manhattan. It was built in 1983 and is 41 stories tall. The octagonal floor of the building and the glass facade contrast with the neighboring high-rise skyscrapers.

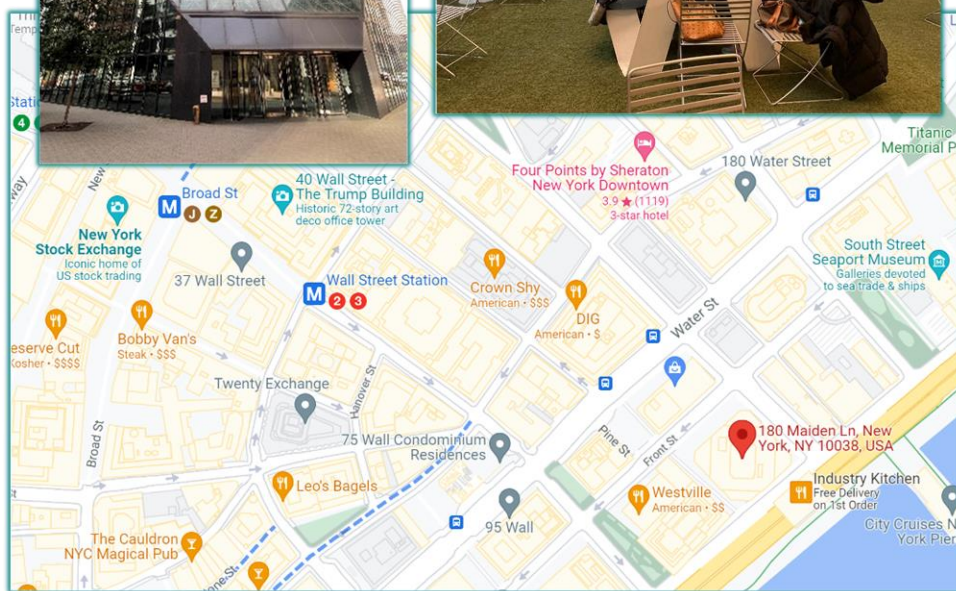
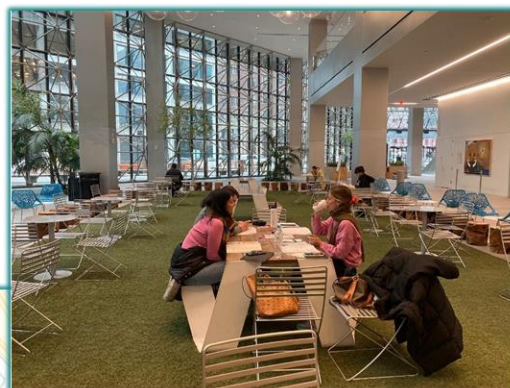

3 COOL THINGS TO DO AFTER YOUR ENGLISH CLASS

1. Take lunch on the grass in Bryant Park surrounded by the skyscrapers, and then visit the world-famous NY public library next door. Check out the famous Rose Reading room on the 3rd floor (5 minutes' walk from Bryant Park)
2. Walk to Grand Central, take lunch in the GC market, visit the whispering gallery, then walk to St Patrick's Cathedral and the Rockefeller Center. Visit Top of the Rock for sunset views of the city (5-7 minutes' walk from Bryant Park)
3. Head over to Times Square to see the neon lights. Then walk 25 mins to Hudson Yards and walk the "vessel", the newest NYC attraction. Later walk the Highline Urban Park (both these are FREE). End your day with dinner in the meatpacking district (5 minutes' walk from Bryant Park)
