

3 COOL THINGS TO DO AFTER YOUR ENGLISH CLASS

1. Walk south along the waterfront to the top end of Battery Park and continue walking along until you reach the southern end. Catch the Staten Island ferry (it's free!) from the Whitehall terminal (next to Battery Park). Once you arrive in Staten Island, 30 mins later, walk back around and take the return ferry. The ferry ride is great for views of New York and the Statue of Liberty.
2. Head North along the waterfront until you reach Little Island. It only takes about 30 minutes to explore this new little park. Then walk across the West side highway to visit the Whitney Museum of American Art. Lots of great stuff here and it's a great building too. After an hour or 2 wandering through this museum, you can walk the famous Highland Park or explore the nearby Meatpacking district.
3. Walk eastwards until you reach Hudson St, and then spend an hour or 2 wandering the lovely streets of the West Village. Enjoy a cupcake from the famous Magnolia's bakery, before walking the short distance to hang out for the rest of the afternoon in Washington Square Park.
