3 COOL THINGS TO DO AFTER YOUR ENGLISH CLASS

1. Walk along the new waterfront at Dumbo, take a photo of the Empire State Building seen through the Manhattan Bridge from Washington Street, the most instagrammable shot in the city! And then walk the Brooklyn Bridge (10 minutes' walk from Brooklyn Bridge Park)
2. Stroll through the historic brownstones of Brooklyn Heights and then catch great views of downtown Manhattan and the Statue of Liberty from the Brooklyn Heights Promenade (10 minutes' walk from Brooklyn Bridge Park)
3. Take the East River ferry up the East River to Williamsburg and explore this hip neighborhood (5 minutes' walk from Brooklyn Bridge Park)
