Morning English classes

To immerse students in NYC life and culture, our classes take place in public places throughout the city, in Dumbo (Brooklyn), Essex Market (Lower East Side), Brookfield Place (Battery Park), Industry City (Brooklyn) and Bryant Park (Midtown). Instead of being in a room with 4 walls, the city becomes the students' classroom! The locations have been chosen based on comfort, space, ease of access, points of interest close by, proximity of public restrooms...

Our classes are rich in cultural content and conversation with an added interactive approach to learning English. In addition to completing homework, book assignments, participating in pair work and discussion, students get the added bonus of learning about NYC in truly authentic NYC settings.

Our teachers are qualified, experienced, and use an action-based, communicative method to encourage students to interact and use the language as much as possible. 8 students per class max, grouped together according to level.

Afternoon program

Our activity program includes the best of NYC and alternates between fun and educational outings. Summer is a great time to discover New York and our students will have the chance to enjoy a typical summer in the city!
